
Archbishop of Sydney Appointment Amending Ordinance
1958

AN ORDINANCE to provide for the amendment of the
Archbishop of Sydney Appointment Ordinance
1931.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Archbishop of Sydney Appointment Ordinance 1931, the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by the Constitutions for the management and good government of the Church of England within the State of New South Wales ordains and rules as follows:—

1. Clause 6 of the said Ordinance shall be and is hereby amended by inserting after the words "Standing Orders of Synod" the following words:—"or if any thirty members of Synod by rising in their places require a ballot then a ballot shall be taken forthwith in such manner as the President shall direct."

2. Clause 7 of the said Ordinance shall be and is hereby amended by inserting immediately before the first proviso in the said clause contained the words:—"The vote upon each name shall be taken upon a show of hands or if any five members of Synod by rising in their places require a division then by a division which shall forthwith be taken in accordance with the Standing Orders of the Synod or if any thirty members of Synod by rising in their places require a ballot then a ballot shall be taken forthwith in such manner as the President shall direct."

3. This Ordinance may be cited as "Archbishop of Sydney Appointment Amending Ordinance 1958."
