

CHURCH OF ENGLAND RETIREMENT VILLAGES
 DAPTO ORDINANCE 1979

No. 14 1979

AN ORDINANCE to further provide for the management and control of the Retirement Villages at Dapto.

WHEREAS by the Church of England Retirement Villages Dapto Constitution Ordinance 1974 provision was made for the government and control of certain land at Dapto and a Retirement Village erected thereon

5 AND WHEREAS it is expedient that further provision be made for the government and control of the said land and Retirement Village NOW the Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in the name and place of such Synod HEREBY ORDAINS RULES DIRECTS AND DECREES as follows:-

10 1. In this ordinance, unless inconsistent with the context or the subject matter:-

"Principal Ordinance" means the Church of England Retirement Villages Dapto Constitution Ordinance 1974-1976 ;

15 "Organisation" means the organisation known as "Church of England Retirement Villages Dapto" and constituted by the Principal Ordinance;

"Board" means the Board of Management constituted by the Principal Ordinance;

20 "Retirement Village" means the land described in the schedule to the Principal Ordinance and the Retirement Village erected thereon; and

"Body Corporate" means Church of England Retirement Villages Diocese of Sydney a body corporate constituted under the Church of England (Bodies Corporate) Act 1938.

25 2. (1) The provisions of Clause 3 shall come into effect on a date specified in writing by the Archbishop.

(2) Before the provisions of Clause 3 come into effect, the Archbishop shall notify, in writing, the Body Corporate and president

of the Board as to the date on which Clause 3 shall come into effect.

3.(1) The organisation shall cease to govern and control the Retirement Village and the Corporation shall govern and control the Retirement Village.

(2) As soon as reasonably possible, the Board shall deliver to the Corporation all books and records relating to the Retirement Village and in the possession of or under the control of the Board and shall pay to the Corporation all moneys held by the Organisation for the purpose or benefit of the Retirement Village.

(3) Clauses 2 to 5 of the Principal Ordinance shall cease to have any effect and on the Board complying with its obligations under sub-clause (2) and under the Accounts Ordinance 1975 (as amended) in relation to the period of twelve months (or such shorter period as may be approved by resolution of the Standing Committee) commencing on the 1st of January 1979, the members of the Board shall cease to hold office and Clauses 6 to 14 of the Principal Ordinance shall cease to have any effect.

4. This ordinance may be cited as "Church of England Retirement Villages Dapto Ordinance 1979".
