
*Clergy Provident Fund Further Amendment
Ordinance, 1937.*

No. 10, 1937.

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the "Clergy Provident Fund Ordinance of 1906 (Sydney)" the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney ordains and rules as follows:—

1. That Clause 27 of the Clergy Provident Fund Ordinance 1906 be omitted and in lieu thereof the following clause be substituted:—

27. In case of the death of a new member before superannuation or before he shall have received one year's superannuation allowance leaving a widow or any child under the age of 16 years there shall be returned to his legal representative all amounts heretofore or hereafter paid to the Fund on account of superannuation exclusive of grants from the "Walter and Eliza Hall" Trust or "The Reserve Fund" subject to deduction for arrears of subscription and interest thereon provided that in the case of a member admitted to membership after the first day of January 1915 the sum to be so returned shall not exceed five pounds for each year of his membership or at the rate thereof.

For definition of "New Member" see Clause 3 of Ordinance 1906.

2. That clause 37 of the Clergy Provident Fund Ordinance 1906 be omitted and in lieu thereof the following clause be substituted:—

37. If any new member resigns his license or is deprived thereof he shall be entitled to the return of the full amount paid to the Fund in respect of his membership during the period of the first ten years of his membership or part thereof and of two-thirds of the amount paid to the Fund in respect of his membership during any further period of his membership without interest exclusive of grants from the "Walter and Eliza Hall" Trust and "The Reserve Fund." Provided that any new member who shall not have been deprived of his license may continue to be a member and shall be entitled to participate in the benefits of the Fund on payment of his full subscription under schedule rates although he may be no longer a resident within the Commonwealth of Australia.

For definition of "New Member" see Clause 3 of Ordinance 1906.

3. This Ordinance shall commence and have effect as from the first day of October in the year One thousand nine hundred and thirty-seven and shall apply only to new members dying or

resigning or being deprived of their licences respectively on or after the lastmentioned date.

4. This Ordinance may be cited as the "Clergy Provident Fund Further Amendment Ordinance of 1937."
