

Emergency Response Training

Are you prepared to save lives?

From fires, bomb threats and medical emergencies, managing your congregation during an emergency situation is a difficult task, made even harder by the nature of Parishes and the diversity of people onsite. To ensure you keep your people safe and lessen the dangers of such an emergency you need a well structured program in place and people who know what to do, quickly.

Course outcome

This course is aimed at those who are responsible for the safety of parishioners during an emergency. On completion of this **3-hour** course, participants will have learned the skills and knowledge to assist parishioners in safely evacuating the premises during an emergency.

What will be covered?

- Types of emergencies that might occur
- Priorities in an emergency
- Responding to an alarm/warning
- Communicating during an emergency
- Responding to fires, medical emergencies, bomb threats and other emergencies
- Evacuating the parish during an emergency
- First attack fire fighting (using fire extinguishers!!)
