
General Assessment Ordinance, 1964

No. 28, 1964.

AN ORDINANCE to assess Parishes, Provisional Parishes and Provisional Districts to provide contributions authorised by the General Assessment Authorisation Ordinance 1959 as amended.

WHEREAS by or under the provisions of the General Assessment Authorisation Ordinance 1959 as amended provision is made inter alia that prior to each ordinary session of Synod the Standing Committee shall prepare a statement showing the sums to be contributed annually by each Parish, Provisional Parish and Provisional District for the purposes therein set out based on an assessment in the manner provided by the said Ordinance AND WHEREAS it is expedient to fix an assessment for two periods of one year to take effect respectively as from the first day of April 1965 and the first day of April 1966 NOW the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in pursuance of the powers and under the provisions of the General Assessment Authorisation Ordinance 1959 as amended HEREBY ORDAINS AND RULES as follows:-

1. The estimates which appear in the first schedule to this Ordinance are hereby approved for and in respect of each of the years ending on the thirty first day of March 1966 and the thirty first day of March 1967.

2. The Synod hereby fixes an amount of Sixty four thousand seven hundred eighty one pounds (£64,781) as an assessment for the period of one year from the first day of April 1965 to the thirty first day of March 1966 in accordance with the details set out in the second schedule hereto.

3. The Synod also hereby fixes an assessment at the rate of Nine pounds (£9) per centum in respect of Parishes and Four pounds ten shillings (£4:10:0) per centum in respect of Provisional Parishes and Provisional Districts on their respective assessable incomes as determined in accordance with the said Ordinance for the year ending on the thirty first day of, March 1965 for the period of one year from the first day of April 1966 to the thirty first day of March 1967 subject to a rebate in the case of Parishes of Eighty pounds (£80) each and in the case of Provisional Parishes and Provisional Districts of Forty pounds (£40) each on the amount of such assessment.
