AN ORDINANCE to amend and supplement the Glebe Administration Ordinance 1930 (No. 15, 1930).

WHEREAS by Clause 14 of the Glebe Administration Ordinance 1930 (hereinafter referred to as the said Ordinance) provision is made for the application of the rents issues and profits of St. Philip's Glebe.

AND WHEREAS by reason of circumstances subsequent to the creation of the trusts to which the said rents issues and profits are subject it is expedient to vary such trusts in manner hereinafter mentioned and to make the further provisions hereinafter contained.

Now the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney ordains directs declares and rules as follows:—

1. By reason of circumstances subsequent to the creation of the trusts to which the said rents issues and profits of St. Philip's Glebe are subject it has become inexpedient to carry out or observe such trusts so far as the said trusts are inconsistent with the provision of this Ordinance.

2. The said Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting in Clause 14 thereof immediately after sub-clause (j) the following new sub-clause, namely:—

(jj) In payment to the Chaplain for Youth a stipend with house and travelling expenses if necessary at such rate and during such period as shall be determined by the Standing Committee and sanctioned by the Archbishop.

3. This Ordinance shall come into force on and not before the first day of January One thousand nine hundred and forty-seven.

4. This Ordinance may be cited as The Glebe Administration Further Amending Ordinance 1946.
