
*"Glebe Administration Further Amendment
Ordinance 1936."*

No. 11, 1936.

AN ORDINANCE to amend and supplement the "Glebe Administration Ordinance 1930" (No. 15, 1930).

WHEREAS by Clause 14 of the "Glebe Administration Ordinance 1930" (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance) provision is made for the application of the rents issues and profits of St. Philip's Glebe.

AND WHEREAS the Principal Ordinance was amended by "The Glebe Administration Amendment Ordinance 1935" and by "The Glebe Administration Further Amendment Ordinance 1936".

AND WHEREAS by reason of circumstances subsequent to the creation of the trusts to which the said rents issues and profits are subject it is expedient to vary such trusts in manner hereinafter mentioned and to make the further provisions hereinafter contained.

Now the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney ordains directs declares and rules as follows:—

1. By reason of circumstances subsequent to the creation of the trusts to which the said rents issues and profits of St. Philip's Glebe are subject it has become inexpedient to carry out or observe such trusts so far as the said trusts are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance.

2. The Principal Ordinance as amended is hereby further amended by inserting in Clause 14 thereof immediately after sub-clause (fff):—

(ffff) In paying to Mrs. Adrienne Elizabeth Talbot the widow of Dean Talbot an allowance at the rate of One hundred pounds per annum as from the first day of August 1936 for so long as the Standing Committee may from time to time direct.
