Ordinance to continue an Ordinance of the 4th Session of the Second Synod intituled "An Ordinance to provide for the election of Bishops to the See of Sydney."

WHEREAS it is expedient to continue for a further period the Ordinance passed on the 19th day of June 1873 and intituled "An Ordinance to provide for the election of Bishops to the See of Sydney" The Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in pursuance of the powers in that behalf conferred upon it by the Constitutions for the management and good government of the United Church of England and Ireland within the Colony of New South Wales and of all other powers vested in the said Synod ordains and rules as follows:—

Ordinance for Election of Bishops continued.

1. The Ordinance intituled "An Ordinance to provide for the election of Bishops to the See of Sydney" shall be and continue in force until the last day of the Second Session of this Synod.

Short Title.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the "Ordinance for the Election of Bishops Continuation Ordinance of 1874."
