

Parish Administration (Inaugural General Meetings) Amendment Ordinance 2014

No 6, 2014

Long Title

An Ordinance to make provision for the inaugural general meeting of a church of a parish or a recognised church.

The Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney Ordains as follows.

1. Name

This Ordinance is the Parish Administration (Inaugural General Meetings) Amendment Ordinance 2014.

2. Amendment of the Parish Administration Ordinance 2008

Insert the following new clause 8 at the end of Part 2 (with consequential renumbering of the existing clauses 8 and 9) –

“Transitional arrangements for the inaugural general meeting of a new parish

8. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Ordinance, upon the creation of a new parish, the Archbishop may determine, for the purpose of the inaugural general meeting of parishioners of a church of the parish –

- (a) the means by which that general meeting is to be convened, and
- (b) the attendance and participation requirements which will qualify a person to take part in the meeting as a parishioner.”

3. Amendment of the Recognised Churches Ordinance 2000

Insert a new clause 13(3) as follows (and renumber the existing clause 13(3) as 13(4)) –

“Notwithstanding clause 13(2), upon a church being declared to be a recognised church, the Archbishop may determine, for the purpose of the inaugural general meeting of members, the attendance and participation requirements which will qualify a person to take part in the meeting as a member.”
