

Pastoral Care and Assistance Appropriation Ordinance 2006

No 24, 2006

Long Title

An Ordinance to provide for the application of certain property for the purposes of Pastoral Care and Assistance.

Preamble

A. Glebe Administration Board holds certain property (the "Property") on trust for the purposes of the Anglican Church of Australia in the Diocese of Sydney under clause 3 of the Diocesan Endowment Ordinance 1984 to be applied in accordance with clauses 4 and 5 of that ordinance.

B. It is expedient to appropriate \$380,000 from the Property for such purposes of the Pastoral Care and Assistance Scheme.

The Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney Ordains as follows.

1. Name

This Ordinance is the Pastoral Care and Assistance Appropriation Ordinance 2006.

2. Direction for payment

Glebe Administration Board is to apply up to \$380,000 from the Property for such purposes of the Pastoral Care and Assistance Scheme as the Diocesan Registrar and the Director of the Professional Standards Unit approves in writing.

3. Interpretation

In this Ordinance a reference to the Pastoral Care and Assistance Scheme means the scheme approved by the Standing Committee by resolution on 29 March 2004 for providing pastoral care and assistance to victims of child sexual assault or sexual misconduct by clergy or church workers as amended from time to time by the Standing Committee.
