

Quorum Ordinance 1984

No. 31, 1984

AN ORDINANCE to provide for a quorum at meetings of certain committees.

The Synod of the Diocese of Sydney HEREBY ORDAINS DIRECTS RULES AND DECLARES as follows: 5

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the "Quorum Ordinance 1984".
- 2. This Ordinance shall apply to each committee established by resolution of the Synod or by resolution of the Standing Committee.
- 3. (1) Subject to sub-clause (2) — 10
 - (a) No business shall be transacted at any meeting of a committee unless a quorum is present at the time when the business is to be transacted.
 - (b) If a quorum is not present within one half an hour from the time appointed for the commencement of a meeting of a committee, the meeting shall be dissolved. 15
 - (c) A quorum shall be one third of all members of a committee. *W.S.A.*

Fractions being counted as one, a quorum shall be one third of all members of a committee except that for a committee of five members or less the quorum shall be two.

(2) The provisions of sub-clause (1) shall apply subject to any provision to the contrary or any other provision in the resolution of the Synod or of the Standing Committee by which a committee is established or in any other resolution of the Synod or of the Standing Committee. 20
