AN ORDINANCE to amend "The Registry and Synod Assessments Ordinance of 1895."

WHEREAS by "The Registry and Synod Assessments Ordinance of 1895" as amended it was provided inter alia that prior to the First Session of each Synod the Standing Committee shall prepare a statement showing the sums to be annually contributed by each parish and district based on an assessment to be fixed in the manner provided in the said Ordinance.

AND WHEREAS it is expedient to fix a provisional assessment for a period of one year to take effect as from the first day of April, 1943, to the thirty-first day of March, 1944.

Now the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney ordains directs declares and rules as follows:—

1. The Registry and Synod Assessments Ordinance 1895 (hereinafter referred to as the said Ordinance) is hereby amended by suspending so much of the provisions of such Ordinance as are inconsistent with this Ordinance and by fixing a provisional assessment for the purposes referred to in such Ordinance for one year from the first day of April, 1943, to the thirty-first day of March, 1944.

2. The Synod hereby fixes an assessment of £3834/7/6 for a period of one year from the first day of April, 1943, to the thirty-first day of March, 1944, the detailed amounts of which are set out in the Schedule hereto provided however that as and when the assessment is fixed by the Synod for the period first day of April, 1943, to the thirty-first day of March, 1946, any adjustments so far as the assessment for the year 1943/4 is concerned shall be made by the Standing Committee.

3. Contributions under this Ordinance shall be held to be due on the first day of April, 1943, and shall be paid to the Standing Committee on or before the thirtieth day of June, 1943.

4. This Ordinance shall be cited as the "Registry and Synod Assessments Amending Ordinance 1942."
