
*Registry and Synod Assessments Amendment Ordinance
of 1948.*

No. 10, 1948.

AN ORDINANCE to amend "The Registry and Synod Assessments Ordinance 1895."

WHEREAS by or under the provision of "The Registry and Synod Assessments Ordinance of 1895" as amended by "The Registry and Synod Assessments Amendment Ordinance of 1896" provision is made inter alia that prior to the first Session of each Synod the Standing Committee shall prepare a statement showing the sums to be annually contributed by each Parish and District based on an assessment for the last preceding three years, and in the manner provided by the said Ordinances.

AND WHEREAS the said Ordinances have been amended from time to time by the following Ordinances, viz.:—

"The Registry and Synod Assessments Amending Ordinance 1937" (No. 11, 1937); the "Registry and Synod Assessments Amending Ordinance 1939" (No. 18, 1939); the "Registry and Synod Assessments Amending Ordinance 1940" (No. 16, 1940); the "Registry and Synod Assessments Amending Ordinance, 1942" (No. 4, 1942); and the "Registry and Synod Assessments Amending Ordinance 1943" (No. 5, 1943).

AND WHEREAS it is expedient to further amend the said Ordinances by fixing an assessment for a period of one year to take effect as from the first day of April 1949 to the thirty-first day of March, 1950, and in certain other particulars.

Now the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney ordains directs declares and rules as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the "Registry and Synod Assessments Amendment Ordinance of 1948."

2. "The Registry and Synod Assessments Ordinance of 1895" as amended by subsequent Ordinances, is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

3. The Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as the "Registry and Synod Assessments Ordinance 1895-1948."

4. The Principal Ordinance is amended:—

- (a) by suspending so much of the provisions of such Ordinance as are inconsistent with this Ordinance and by fixing an assessment for the purposes referred to in such Ordinance for the year commencing on the first day of April, 1949, and ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1950.
- (b) The Synod hereby fixes an assessment of £5940 13s. 3d. for the period of one year from the first day of April 1949 to the thirty-first day of March, 1950, in accordance with the schedule hereto.
- (c) Contributions under this Ordinance shall be held to be due on the first day of April 1949 and shall be paid to the Standing Committee on or before the thirtieth day of June, 1949.

(d) By omitting from Clause 1:—

the words "Mission District and Conventional District and inserting in lieu thereof the words "Parochial District and Provisional District."

and by adding at the end of the said Clause the words

"and any other votes of money as authorised from time to time by the Synod or if the Synod is not in Session by the Standing Committee."

- (e) by omitting from Clause 2 the words "one month" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "two months" and by inserting in the same Clause:—
 - (i) after the words "Collections made in Church" the words "and from such other sources as the Standing Committee shall from time to time determine."
 - (ii) and by adding at the end of the said Clause the words "A certified copy of the Statement of Receipts and Disbursements of each Church in the Parish or District is to be forwarded to the Standing Committee with the said return."

(f) by omitting from Clause 3:—

(i) the words "for the last preceding three years" and inserting in lieu thereof the words:—

"for the last preceding four years excluding the last year thereof." Provided however that the assessment to be made by the Synod in 1951 for the period 1st April 1952 to 31st March 1955 shall be based on the average income for two years namely 1948/9, and 1949/50 instead of the average income for three years, and the assessment be made by the Synod in 1954 for the period 1st April 1955 to 31st March, 1958 shall be based on the average income for the three years namely 1950/1, 1951/2, and 1952/3, and thereafter in accordance with the beforementioned amendment to this Clause 3.

(ii) by omitting from the same Clause:—

the words "Mission Districts and Conventional Districts and inserting in lieu thereof the words:—
"Parochial Districts and Provisional Districts."

(g) (i) by omitting from Clause 4:—

the words "not later than the 30th day of June in the year in which it is made" and inserting in lieu thereof the words:—

"as soon as is practicable."

(ii) and by adding to the end of the said Clause the words:—

"Provided that no appeal shall be considered by the Standing Committee if the returns are not lodged by the Parish or District within the time limit provided for by Clause 2 of the Principal Ordinance."
