
*Registry and Synod Assessments Amendment Ordinance
of 1952.*

No. 6, 1952.

AN ORDINANCE to amend "The Registry and Synod Assessments Ordinance 1895-1951."

WHEREAS the "Registry and Synod Assessments Ordinance of 1895" has been amended from time to time.

AND WHEREAS included in such amendments was the "Registry and Synod Assessments Amendment Ordinance of 1948" (No. 10 of 1948).

AND WHEREAS by Clause 4 (f) (1) provision was made for the Assessment for the period 1st April, 1952, to 31st March, 1955, to be based upon the average income, namely, 1948/9 and 1949/50.

AND WHEREAS the "Registry and Synod Assessments Amendment Ordinance 1951" (No. 28 of 1951) fixed the Assessment for the year 1st April, 1952, to 31st March, 1953, on the average income of 1948/9 and 1949/50.

AND WHEREAS it is intended to fix the Assessment by this Ordinance from 1st April, 1953 to 31st March, 1954,

Now the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney ordains directs declares and rules as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the "Registry and Synod Assessments Amendment Ordinance of 1952."

2. The Registry and Synod Assessments Ordinance 1895-1951 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

3. The Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as the "Registry and Synod Assessments Ordinance 1895-1952."

4. The Principal Ordinance is amended—

(a) By suspending so much of the provisions of such Ordinance as are inconsistent with this Ordinance and by

fixing an assessment for the purposes referred to in such Ordinance for the year commencing on the first day of April, 1953, and ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1954.

- (b) The Synod hereby fixes an assessment of £11,202 19s 9d. for the period of one year from the first day of April, 1953, to the thirty-first day of March, 1954, in accordance with the Schedule hereto.
- (c) Contributions under this Ordinance shall be held to be due on the first day of April, 1953, and shall be paid to the Standing Committee on or before the thirtieth day of June, 1953.
