
St. Catherine's Clergy Daughters' School Further Amending Ordinance, 1950.

No. 23, 1950

AN ORDINANCE to amend further "The Saint Catherine's Clergy Daughters' School Ordinance, 1922."

The Synod of the Diocese of Sydney ordains and rules as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the "St. Catherine's Clergy Daughters' School Further Amending Ordinance, 1950."

2. (a) "St. Catherine's Clergy Daughters' School Ordinance, 1922" is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(b) The Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as "The St. Catherine's Clergy Daughters' School Ordinance 1922-1950."

3. The Principal Ordinance is amended:—

1. (a) by omitting the word "fifteen" in line 4 of Clause 3 and substituting the word "sixteen" in lieu thereof.

(b) by omitting the word "and" in line 7 of the said Clause 3 and adding at the end of the clause the words "and one member of St. Catherine's Old Girls' Union being a member of the Church of England shall be appointed by the said Union, so long as such Union is in existence and consists of not less than fifty financial members."

2. By adding at the end of Clause 7 the words:—

"With respect to the members of the Council appointed by the St. Catherine's Old Girls' Union, whenever there shall be a vacancy as aforesaid, such vacancy shall be filled up by the appointment of a new member by the members of the said St. Catherine's Old Girls' Union if such Union is then in existence and consists of not less than fifty financial members."

3. By adding at the end of Clause 10 the words:—
"the member appointed by the St. Catherine's Old Girls' Union shall retire at each ordinary session of the Synod, but shall be eligible for re-appointment and the vacancy so created shall be filled by the said Union within a period not exceeding three months after each ordinary session of Synod."
