

ST LUKE'S LIVERPOOL ORDINANCE (NO.1) 1988

No. 5, 1988

AN ORDINANCE to vary the trusts on which certain property is held.

WHEREAS

A. Anglican Church Property Trust Diocese of Sydney is the trustee of certain investments held upon trusts set forth in the St. Luke's Liverpool Land Sale Ordinance 1920.

B. By reason of circumstances which have arisen subsequent to the creation of the said trusts it is expedient that the same be varied to the extent provided in this Ordinance.

NOW the Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in the name and place of the said Synod HEREBY ORDAINS DECLARES DIRECTS AND RULES as follows:

1. This Ordinance may be cited as "St. Luke's Liverpool Ordinance (No.1) 1988".

2. By reason of circumstances which have arisen subsequent to the creation of the trusts hereinbefore referred to it is inexpedient to carry out and observe the same to the extent that the same are hereby varied.

3. Anglican Church Property Trust Diocese of Sydney is authorised and empowered to realise all investments held upon the trusts set forth in the St. Luke's Liverpool Sale Ordinance 1920 and to pay the net proceeds from the realisation of the said investments to the churchwardens for the time being of St. Luke's Church at Liverpool to be applied by them in or towards the purposes set forth in Clause 3 of that Ordinance.
