
*St. Paul's (Sydney) Land Resumption Amendment
Ordinance 1930.*

AN ORDINANCE to further amend "The St. Paul's (Sydney) Land Resumption Ordinance 1911."

WHEREAS it is expedient to further amend "The St. Paul's (Sydney) Land Resumption Ordinance 1911" by making further provision for the application of the income arising from the investments now in the hands of the Church of England Property Trust Diocese of Sydney and by varying certain trusts as to the same.

Now therefore the Standing Committee of the Diocese of Sydney in pursuance of the powers in that behalf conferred upon it by the Constitutions for the management and good government of the Church of England within the State of New South Wales and by the Church of England Trust Property Act 1917 and the "Land Ordinance Procedure and Delegation of Powers Ordinance 1926" and otherwise ordains directs and declares as follows:—

1. By reason of circumstances subsequent to the creation of the said trusts mentioned in "The St. Paul's (Sydney) Land Resumption Ordinance 1911" it has become inexpedient to carry out or observe the same to the extent to which they are inconsistent with this Ordinance.

2. Clause 7 of the said Ordinance is amended by adding the following words:—

"Provided nevertheless that the Corporate Trustees shall out of the said net income pay to the Venerable Archdeacon Francis Bertie Boyce from and after the 30th day of November 1930 for and during his lifetime a superannuation allowance at the rate of one hundred pounds per annum."

3. This Ordinance may be cited as the "St. Paul's (Sydney) Land Resumption Amendment Ordinance 1930."
