
The St. Philip's Sydney Incumbency Ordinance, 1953.

No. 22, 1953.

AN ORDINANCE to amend Saint Philip's Sydney (Rectorship) and Moore Theological College (Principalship) Ordinance 1935 (No. 15, 1935) and matters incidental thereto.

The Synod of the Diocese of Sydney ordains, directs and rules as follows:—

1. Clauses two, three, four, five, six and seven of the St. Philip's Sydney (Rectorship) and Moore Theological College (Principalship) Ordinance, 1935, are hereby repealed, but such repeal shall not affect any matter or thing done pursuant to the abovementioned clauses.

2. Clause 2 of the Moore Theological College Ordinance of 1919 is amended by adding after the word "Trustees" where first appearing the following words "to appoint the Principal after consultation with the Committee and."

3. The Venerable Thomas Chatterton Hammond, M.A., Th.D., Archdeacon, shall continue to be Rector of the Parish of St. Philip Sydney and upon a vacancy occurring thereafter the provisions of the Presentation and Exchange Ordinance, 1933, or any Ordinance amending or taking the place of the same shall apply to the said Parish.

4. This Ordinance shall be styled and cited as "The St. Philip's Sydney Incumbency Ordinance, 1953."
