
Standing Committee Ordinance Amendment.

111915

AN ORDINANCE to amend the "Standing Committee Ordinance of 1897" by varying the Constitution of the Standing Committee.

WHEREAS it is expedient that the Constitution of the Standing Committee should be varied WHEREFORE the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by the Constitutions for the management and good government of the Church of England within the State of New South Wales and of all other powers vested in the said Synod ordains and rules as follows:—

1. Sub-section (2) of section 1 of the "Standing Committee Ordinance of 1897" shall be so varied as to read as follows:—

(2) The Standing Committee shall consist of *ex officio* members and elected members. The *ex officio* members shall be the Archbishop the Dean the two Senior Archdeacons other than the Dean and the Honorary Secretaries of the Synod for the time being. The elected members shall consist of ten Clerical and nineteen Lay members of the Synod who shall be elected at the first session of every Synod.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the "Standing Committee Ordinance Amending Ordinance of 1915."
