AN ORDINANCE to amend the "Sydney Church of England Grammar School Ordinance of 1894."

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend in certain respects the "Sydney Church of England Grammar School Ordinance of 1894" THE SYNOD OF THE DIOCESE OF SYDNEY in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by the Constitutions for the management and good government of the Church of England within the State of New South Wales ordains and rules as follows:—

1. Section 3 of the said Ordinance is hereby repealed.

2. Whenever a vacancy shall be occasioned in the Council of the said School either by the death resignation or lunacy of any member of such Council or by the refusal or neglect or incapacity on the part of any such person to discharge the duties of his office or by reason of any such person having been absent from the meetings of the Council without leave for three months in succession such vacancy when the Synod is not in Session shall be filled by the remaining members of the Council. Any person so appointed shall remain in office only until the next ordinary Session of the Synod.

This Ordinance may be cited as the "Sydney Church of England Grammar School (Amendment) Ordinance 1910."
