
Sydney Church Ordinance Amendment.

AN ORDINANCE to amend the "Sydney Church Ordinance," so as to allow of married women voting at Vestry Meetings.

(Assented to 23 September, 1898.)

WHEREAS it is expedient that married women should be entitled to vote at Vestry Meetings, the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in pursuance of the powers in that behalf conferred upon it by the Constitutions for the management and good government of the United Church of England and Ireland within the Colony of New South Wales, ordains and rules as follows:—

1. The words "members of the Church of England" in clause 14 of the "Sydney Church Ordinance" shall include married women.

2. The words "occupier of a seat" in clause 40 of the "Sydney Church Ordinance" shall include a married woman.

3. This Ordinance may be cited as the "Sydney Church Ordinance Amendment Ordinance, 1898."
