

Synod Elections (Sydney Town Hall) Amendment Ordinance 2005

No 11, 2005

Long Title

An Ordinance to amend the rules that apply to the conduct of Synod elections at the first ordinary session of the 47th Synod.

The Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney Ordains as follows.

1. Name

This Ordinance is the Synod Elections (Sydney Town Hall) Amendment Ordinance 2005.

2. Amendment

For the purposes of conducting a ballot at or during the first ordinary session of the 47th Synod, rule 5.4 of the Schedule to the Synod Elections Ordinance 2000 is taken to be amended as follows –

- (a) each reference to “first appointed day” is taken to be a reference to “second appointed day”, and
- (b) each reference to “second appointed day” or “second day” is taken to be a reference to “third appointed day” or “third day” respectively.

3. Commencement

(1) Subject to subclause (2), this ordinance commences on the date assent is given to the ordinance.

(2) Clause 2 commences on the date the Archbishop convenes the first ordinary session of the 47th Synod by summons stating that the place of the meeting for the first day of the session will be the Sydney Town Hall.
