

Uninsured Liability Appropriation Ordinance 2004

No 3, 2004

Long Title

An Ordinance to provide for the application of certain property for the purpose of providing for uninsured liability.

Preamble

A. Glebe Administration Board holds a provision for distribution (the "Provision") on trust under the Diocesan Endowment Ordinance 1984 to be applied in accordance with clauses 4 and 5 of that ordinance.

B. Certain unforeseen liabilities have arisen for which there is no insurance cover.

C. Due to circumstances which have arisen after the creation of the trusts upon which the Provision is held, it is inexpedient to carry out or observe those trusts and it is inexpedient to apply \$270,000 of the Provision for the same or like purposes as those trusts.

D. It is expedient to appropriate \$270,000 from the Provision for the purpose of providing for uninsured liability.

The Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney Ordains as follows.

1. Name

This Ordinance is the Uninsured Liability Appropriation Ordinance 2004.

2. Declaration

By reason of circumstances which have arisen after the creation of the trusts on which the Provision is held, it is inexpedient to carry out or observe those trusts and it is inexpedient to apply \$270,000 of the Provision for the same or like purposes as those trusts.

3. Direction for payment

Glebe Administration Board is to apply up to \$270,000 from the Provision for the purpose of providing for uninsured liability in accordance with a direction given by the Registrar and the person who holds the office of Director under the Church Discipline Ordinance 2002.
